

Presentation of the new edition of the Apor Codex

Together, they make up the so-called Hussite Bible raising a plethora of questions which have not been answered until today."

The exhibition was organized jointly by the Székely National Museum of Sepsiszentgyörgy, National Széchényi Library and the Institute of Hungarian Linguistics and Finno-Ugric Studies of Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest.

The volume comes complete with a DVD comprising a digitized copy of the codex.
