Ice cream and crafts – globe gluing, puzzle of corvina motifs and mini Arany book making!

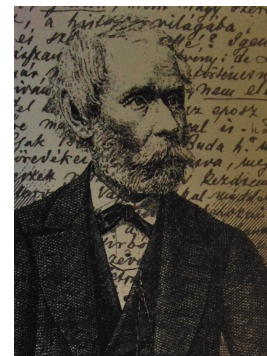
